Section 5654-1, General Code, provides that such bonds shall not be advertised for sale nor issued until the contract has been let, and shall be issued in an amount not exceeding the full amount of the accepted bid more than the estimated amount of such other items of cost as may be legally included in the total cost of such construction and improvement.

Since the issuance of these bonds the contract price has been determined and certified to this office as being \$5,130.00. In order to comply with the provisions of section 5654-1, G. C., it will therefore be necessary to pass an amending bond resolution reducing the amount of the original resolution to the sum of \$5,130.00, and as the provisions of the foregoing section will require that the bonds in the reduced amount shall be advertised for sale, this will necessitate the disapproval of the issue in the sum of \$6,336.00, and you are therefore advised not to accept said bonds as they have been issued in accordance with the provisions of section 5654-1, G. C.
