Narrative:

On Monday, September 15, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Dan Boerner (SA Boerner) reviewed the personnel / training records for [REDACTED] from the Ashtabula County Sheriff's Office (ACSO). SA Boerner noted the following:
