The resolution of the county commissioners authorizing the issuance of bonds as set forth in the transcript presented for examination provides for the issuance of bonds in the denominations and in the amounts set forth in the heading and I suggest that you amend your resolutions of purchase so that the amounts and denominations and due date of the bonds will comply with the resolution of the county commissioners. To that end I am enclosing the transcript and request that you return it to me as I will need it when the bonds are presented at the office of the treasurer of state for delivery.
