APPROVAL—GRANTS OF EASEMENT, STATE OF OHIO,
THROUGH CONSERVATION COMMISSIONER, TWELVE
GRANTORS, THOMPSON TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUN-
TY, OHIO, FOR PUBLIC FISHING GROUNDS.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval certain grants of easement, executed to the State of Ohio by several property owners in Thompson Township, Delaware County, Ohio, conveying to the State of Ohio, for the purposes therein stated, certain tracts of land in said township and county.
