DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my approval contract between the State of Ohio, acting by the Adjutant General of Ohio, and F. A. Garner and Harry Murphy, a partnership, of Lynchburg, Ohio. This contract covers the State Armory Building to be erected at Steubenville, Ohio, and calls for an expenditure of \$50,503.00.

You have submitted the certificate of the Director of Finance to the effect that there are unencumbered balances legally appropriated in a sum sufficient to cover the obligations of the contract. There has further been submitted a contract bond upon which H. G. Murphy, H. N. Henderson and John R. Benham, appear as sureties, sufficient to cover the amount of the contract.

You have further submitted evidence indicating that plans were properly prepared and approved, notice to bidders was properly given, bids tabulated as required by law and the contract duly awarded. Also it appears that the law relating to the workman's compensation has been complied with.

Finding said contract and bond in proper legal form I have this day noted my approval thereon and return the same herewith to you, together with all other data submitted in this connection.
