Narrative:

On Monday, March 30, 2026, the Harrison County Sheriff's Office (HCSO) requested Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) assistance at the scene of an officer-involved critical incident at 31000 Block U.S. Route 250, Uhrichsville, Ohio 44683. As part of that investigation, Special Agent (SA) Dan Boerner (SA Boerner) was requested to attend the post-mortem examination of the decedent (Michael W. Decker). The examination was conducted on Wednesday, April 1, 2026, at the Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner's Office (OU2026-00133) in Cuyahoga County, Ohio. The post-mortem examination was conducted by Dr. Daniel Sullivan (dsullivan02@cuyahogacounty.gov).

The following observations were made during the course of the autopsy:

- Gunshot wound to the chest with a fragment/projectile recovered in the back.
- Gunshot wound near the right eye exiting near the left ear. No fragment/projectile recovered.

SA Boerner requested to receive a copy of the full autopsy and toxicology reports and autopsy photographs once available.
