**Narrative:**

On Friday, March 28, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Kyle Douglass (SA Douglass) received Ohio BCI Laboratory report(s) for items of evidence submitted on December 26, 2024 for scientific analysis (laboratory case number 24-127171). The report originated from the Firearms section of the laboratory and was authored by Forensic Scientist Kelsey Cramer (FS Cramer). SA Douglass reviewed the laboratory report and noted the following:

Firearms discharged by Gahanna Police Department (GPD) officers involved in the incident were collected by the BCI Crime Scene Unit (CSU). One additional firearm was recovered during the incident which reportedly did not belong to any law enforcement officers on scene, which was also collected by BCI CSU. Firearms believed to be related to the incident were subsequently submitted to the BCI firearms lab for analysis.

FS Cramer identified the firearm with serial #JDZ1795 as a Smith & Wesson M&P9 Shield 9mm semi-automatic pistol, which is registered to [REDACTED]

[REDACTED]. This firearm was in the possession of Alex Russell (Russell) during the incident and found in Russell's vicinity by GPD officers after the incident had concluded. CSU agents/technicians collected this firearm at the scene with one (1) cartridge in the chamber and five additional cartridges in the magazine. According to the firearms lab operability report, BCI Forensic Scientist Alexander Salmons (FS Salmons) found this firearm to be operable.

While processing the scene, CSU agents/technicians also recovered cartridge cases and fired projectiles in the vicinity of the incident. Numerous cartridge cases and fired bullet projectiles were submitted to the lab for analysis.

FS Cramer identified one (1) fired cartridge case and one (1) fired bullet as being source identified to the firearm with serial # [REDACTED], which is a Smith & Wesson M&P15 .223 caliber patrol rifle found on scene and is reportedly assigned to GPD [REDACTED]

FS Cramer identified three (3) fired cartridge cases and two (2) fired bullets as being source identified to the firearm with serial [REDACTED], a Glock 17 9mm semi-automatic pistol which is assigned to GPD [REDACTED]


