On May 3, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Andrew Harasimchuk (Harasimchuk) completed a Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) eTrace on the following firearm: an Industria National De Armes, model 3, .38 caliber firearm, bearing a serial number of 053704. This firearm was recovered on Interstate 77 Southbound at Exit #85 in New Philadelphia, Ohio. This firearm was reportedly possessed by and possibly used by Kenneth Floyd Woodard.
