APPROVAL, TWO LEASES TO LAND IN BLOOM TOWNSHIP, SENECA COUNTY, OHIO, FOR STATE GAME REFUGE PURPOSES—CHARLES W. LYTLE AND LLOYD H. HAWBLITZ.

DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my examination and approval two certain leases executed to the State of Ohio by property owners in Bloom Township, Seneca County, Ohio, leasing and demising to the state for the purpose therein stated, tracts of land in said township and county.

The leases here in question, designated with respect to the number of the lease, the owner of the property and the acreage of land covered by the leases, are as follows:

These leases are for a term of five years and the property described is leased to the state for the sole purpose of a state game refuge. And, in this connection, it is noted that as to these leases the Conservation Council, acting through you as Conservation Commissioner, has made an order setting aside the lands described in the lease for the purpose of a state game and bird refuge, as provided for in section 1435-1, General Code.

Upon examination of these leases, I find that the same have been executed and acknowledged by the respective lessors in the manner provided by law.
