Narrative:

On Friday, April 19, 2024 at 0730 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Chad Holcomb (SA Holcomb), Whitehall Police Department Officer Enrique Ortega (Ofc. Ortega) and Detective Dustin Willis interviewed William Villatoro (Villatoro), relative to the officer-involved shooting which took place on Friday, April 19, 2024. The interview took place at the Whitehall Police Department (WPD) interview room. The purpose of the interview was to obtain all relevant information of the incident known or observed by this individual.

Villatoro was the driver of the vehicle that Santiago Alfaramunoz was in during the shooting.

Villatoro did not speak any English, so Ofc. Ortega translated. Villatoro said that he lived on State Route 161, Apartment 227 but wasn't sure of the exact address.

Villatoro was in custody by WPD, so Ofc. Ortega read him his Miranda Rights; he immediately stated that he wanted an attorney.

Ofc. Ortega then told Villatoro that he was going to be arrested for improperly handling firearms in a motor vehicle. He was also informed that his friend, Alfaramunoz was deceased. Villatoro immediately stated that he got out of the vehicle when the officer told him to and that the guns belonged to his friend. Alfaramunoz asked for a ride to his girlfriend's house.

Villatoro was then asked again if he wanted an attorney; he stated yes. The interview was then terminated.

The interview concluded at approximately 0737 hours.
