CONTRACT FORM—EXTRA WORK—APPROVAL.

COLUMBUS, OHIO, September 18, 1928.

HON. HARRY J. KIRK, Director of Highways, Columbus, Ohio.

DEAR SIR:—This is to acknowledge receipt of your communication under date of September 7, 1928, submitting for my examination and approval an extra work contract form for use in cases provided for by Section 1210 of the General Code.

On examination of the same, I am of the opinion that the form submitted by you is suitable for use in the cases provided for by the last sentence of the second paragraph of Section 1210, General Code, which reads as follows:

"When it is deemed necessary by the director to perform extra work in connection with any project and the proposal of the contractor contains no unit price bid covering the item or items involved in such extra work and the cost of such work does not exceed two thousand dollars, the director may enter into a contract covering such extra work without advertising for and receiving bids therefor."

However, it occurs to me that the contract form submitted by you is not suitable for use in cases provided for by the first part of the second paragraph of Section 1210, General Code, relating to the matter of extra work on unit price contracts. The part of said paragraph in the section above referred to, reads as follows:

"In connection with any project where the director desires to increase the quantities of any item or items in excess of twenty per cent of such item, or in excess of two thousand dollars in connection with any one item on account of unforeseen contingencies not included in the original contract, he shall enter into an extra work contract covering such increase and the provisions relating to the advertising for bids shall apply to the letting of such extra work contract. Provided, that, if an emergency exists which will not permit of the delay necessary to advertise said extra work, such contract for extra work may then be let without any advertising whatever. The director shall make a finding of such fact on his journal."

To provide for the cases contemplated by the provisions of Section 1210, General Code, just quoted, I have prepared and herewith inclose a form of extra work contract which will be suitable for the purpose. In this connection you will note the provisions of the section above quoted and to the effect that such extra work contract can only be entered into after advertising for bids on such extra work, unless you, as Director of Highways, make a finding on your journal that an emergency exists which will not permit of the delay necessary to advertise for bids for such extra work.
