**Narrative:**

On Friday, January 09, 2026, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Dan Boerner (SA Boerner) reviewed the personnel file for ██████████ ██████████ from the Champion Township Police Department (CPD) and noted the following:

***Personnel File***

██████████ personnel file consisted of discipline records, employment records and training records.

██████████ was sworn in as a full-time Champion Township Police Department (CPD) police officer on ██████████. Prior to being sworn in as a full-time police officer, ██████████ ██████████ was a part-time police officer for the CPD from ██████████.

No discipline related to the on-duty use of force was located within the personnel files.

On ██████████ ██████████ received a five (5) day suspension for an off-duty incident involving an altercation at a bar within the jurisdiction of CPD.

***Range Qualification Records***

On Saturday, October 19, 2024, ██████████ completed the annual firearm qualification with a Glock 22 40 caliber, SN: ██████████ semi-automatic handgun. This was the same firearm used during the incident.

Pursuant to Article 8, Discipline, you are hereby provided with this Notice of Discipline. Please be advised you are charged with the following violations:

Standards of Conduct; 319  
General Standards; 319.4  
Performance; 319.5.8  
Conduct; 319.5.9

These charges are based upon the summarized incident below demonstrating a pattern of your performance:

### *Incident:*

On  you were involved in an off-duty altercation at the Beach House Bar. Previously you had been warned by the Chief of Police to stay away from this location. During this altercation you initially attempted to intervene but quickly became an aggressor. You are seen on security video obtained from the bar, grabbing a male subject three separate times around the neck. During this time, you had more than enough opportunity to remove yourself from the situation. The incident quickly evolved into a scrum where you were eventually injured and required immediate medical attention. You never notified any on duty law enforcement of the incident, nor this agency which has jurisdiction where the altercation happened until reporting off from duty later in the morning.

As a public servant we are often thrust into the view of the public. Too often officers are painted with a broad brush based upon the conduct or misconduct of other officers. This unfairly tarnishes the image of all who have been given the honor to serve and protect. The public holds officers to a high standard. When an officer violates the rules, they break the public trust and lose credibility. Your conduct in this listed incident demonstrates your recklessness and lack of

accountability that I must not ignore. This conduct brings discredit to the Champion Police Department and all of the officers working hard to keep the community's trust.

Based upon the above violations, I recommended to the Champion Township Board of Trustees, that you be suspended without pay for (5) working days. The Board of Trustees have met on September 18, 2025 and agreed with this discipline. This is with the understanding and emphasis that similar violations within the next 12 months will result in additional discipline to include possible termination.

You will serve a total of a (5) day suspension (40 working hours).

However, in lieu of suspension, you will be given the option to forfeit (5) days of accrued vacation leave. This by no means diminishes the seriousness of these violations but takes into consideration the effect a suspension would have on the township and your fellow officers who have had to work extra hours during your time off.

In compliance with Article 10, Section 4 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement, I am providing you with a notification of your rights.

- You have the right to object by filing a grievance within seven (7) days of the occurrence of the facts giving rise to the grievance (Notice of Discipline).
- The grievance procedure provides for a hearing before the Board of Trustees and ultimately an independent arbitrator as its final step as outlined in Article 11, Sections one through six.
- You are entitled to a representation by a union representative throughout.

## FIELD TRAINING MANUAL

### INTRODUCTION

The field training manual is designed to summarize the duties, and responsibilities of those involved in the training process, in addition to having documentation of the duties performed by the trainee.

The intent of the field training manual is to guide the probationary officer through the subsequent steps of development until the probationary officer is ready to function without constant coaching from the field training officer. The Field Training Program is offered as an extensive, thorough, individualized experience for new officer's regardless of previous experience. It is our desire to assist the probationary officer in becoming a fully prepared officer for our department. Each police agency has different policies, procedures, and overall ways to handle a variety of situations. It is the best interest of the Champion Police Department to provide the knowledge of our individual procedures to the new officer.

It is the Champion Police Department's goal to provide a greater emphasis on training, and to view training as an important part in providing the highest level of service to the community. The future of the community rests upon the quality of training received by today's probationary police officer's. Every officer should view this as the opportunity to enhance the reputation of the Agency as a leader in law enforcement.

# **FIELD TRAINING OFFICER (FTO) MANUAL**

## **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE FIELD TRAINING OFFICER**

Every officer assigned to work with the probationary, reserve, or part time officer is acting in some way as a field training officer (FTO) regardless of title or rank within the department. Officer's may be appointed by the Chief of Police as "regular basis" training officer's for the trainee. Duties of the FTO are as followed:

- Assisting the trainee in setting clear, job related learning goals
- Using practical and innovative methods of instruction and providing
- remedial training when necessary to teach the probationer how to do the duties of a police officer
- Providing the trainee with clear and specific feedback on performance
- Notifying a supervisor of any serious, deficient, misconduct, or policy
- Violations. Included is issues with performance, or other problems related to training
- Documenting the trainee's performance for review by supervisory personnel

## **DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED OF THE FIELD TRAINING OFFICER**

Each FTO is required to document the performance of each assigned trainee. The required documentation will be in two sections including: Daily Observation Reports (DOR) which will be completed daily. The DOR will evaluate and explain daily duties performed by the trainee and record the overall actions and progress. The second form of documentation will be an overall check list including places, topics, or actions that were explained and

performed. Each will be marked off with the date and FTO of which the items were completed.

The Daily Observation Report (DOR) is a performance evaluation form which includes multiple categories which the field training officer will utilize to formally record and report "On the job" performance. The purpose of this debriefing is to assist the trainee in correcting areas of deficient performance and further strengthen those areas in which he/she stands in terms of performance.

There is no set amount of time an officer is actively involved in field training. Each officer is different with different experience levels. The amount of time it takes an officer to complete field training is based off of the totality of circumstances involved including call volume, comprehension, ect. It will be the overall decision of the Chief of Police to determine when a trainee is ready to move on to the next phase of training. Each phase shall be the following:

- Ride with Field Training Officer as rider and secondary officer
- Operator of the patrol unit with the Field Training Officer in the vehicle
- Operate a patrol unit by themselves with another officer on duty with them to assist with calls.

It is only when the trainee is able to handle calls and a variety of situations on their own, and in their own patrol unit without any assistance of the Field Training Officer it can be considered to release the trainee from field training. Upon review of daily observation reports, overall checklist of performed duties, and the recommendation of the field training officer and/or supervisor to the Chief of Police and approval by the Chief can the trainee be completed with field training.

## FIELD TRAINING OFFICER (FTO) MANUAL

Department leaders and field training program staff have a responsibility to the community they serve. This responsibility requires that the department train and retain only the most competent officers. Not everyone has the capability to perform the complex, demanding tasks of the patrol officer position. If, after sufficient training, the trainee does not meet the acceptable standards he/she must be removed from patrol duties. To do otherwise would be an injustice to the department, the community it serves, and to the trainee.

To accomplish the field training task requires the utmost dedication and patience throughout the department. All levels must support the training mission and accommodate training needs. The future of the department rests in the implementation of a well organized and administered field training program. Support of the program and the program staff will result in successful trainees who can perform the duties of a patrol officer in a safe, effective, and competent manner.

The role of the field training program trainee is to demonstrate the ability to perform at a solo uniformed patrol officer level by the end of the program. This is the standard by which the trainee will be measured throughout the training program. The trainee's primary responsibility while assigned to the field training program is to devote his/her full attention and efforts toward successfully completing that program. This may be a very intense and stressful time in the trainee's life. The field training program staff will make every effort to provide the tools necessary for the trainee to succeed in this task. Trainees must simply give their best effort each and every moment they are assigned to the program.

## FIELD TRAINING OFFICER (FTO) MANUAL

Expectations of Trainees Trainee's are to be respectful to their FTOs and other program staff. The FTO's direction is to be accepted and followed at all times. If the trainee believes that a specific order is improper, or an evaluation is not fair, he/she should discuss it with the FTO. If the trainee is still unable to resolve the issue, the trainee should ask to meet with a supervisor such as the Sergeant. If the trainee still has a concern or problem, the trainee may bring the concerns to the Chief of Police. Trainees will complete all assignments in a prompt, timely manner. They will follow all policy and procedures as outlined in the department manuals. Trainees should ask questions when they arise. FTOs are an information resource and trainees should not wait for the FTO to cover an area of concern they may have. Trainees shall channel their efforts into recognizing and correcting the error(s).

While off duty, trainees should not respond to police calls, nor should they conduct police investigations/ duties unless the situation is life threatening. Trainees should discuss these types of situations with their FTO and follow department policy when dealing with off-duty situations. Trainees will receive evaluations (Daily Observation Reports, Weekly Training Progress Reports, Supervisor Weekly Reports, and End of Phase Reports). Trainees should use these forms to track their progress and to help identify any areas requiring additional effort on their part. Trainees should be open and honest during the review of these evaluations. Trainees shall be receptive to constructive criticism given by FTOs and field training program staff. They may verbalize an explanation for their action; however, repeated rationalization, excessive verbal contradictions, and hostility are not acceptable and are counter productive to the field training program itself. Trainees' relationships with field training program staff, other trainees, and co-workers shall be respectful and strictly professional, both on and off duty, while they are in the training program.




