APPROVAL—GRANT OF EASEMENT, STATE OF OHIO, THROUGH CONSERVATION COMMISSIONER, WITH HEIRS OF W. C. SWISHER ESTATE, TRACT OF LAND, NUMBERED AND DESIGNATED, JEFFERSON TOWNSHIP, WILLIAMS COUNTY, OHIO, FOR PUBLIC FISHING GROUNDS AND TO IMPROVE THE WATERS OR WATER COURSES PASSING THROUGH AND OVER SAID LAND.
