APPROVAL—BOND FOR THE FAITHFUL PERFORMANCE OF HIS DUTIES AS RESIDENT DIVISION DEPUTY DIRECTOR—ARCHIE E. RANNEY.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my approval a bond, in the penal sum of \$5,000, with sureties as indicated, to cover the faithful performance of the duties of the official as hereinafter listed:

Archie E. Ranney, Resident Division Deputy Director—
The Glens Falls Indemnity Company.

The above bond is evidently executed pursuant to the provisions of Sections 1182 and 1182-3, General Code, which provide, so far as pertinent:

“Sec. 1182. * * * Each division deputy director shall give bond in the sum of five thousand dollars, conditioned for the faithful performance of his duties with sureties to the approval of the state highway director. * * *”

“Sec. 1182-3. * * * All bonds hereinbefore provided for shall be conditioned upon the faithful discharge of the duties of their respective positions, and such bonds * * * shall be approved as to the sufficiency of the sureties by the director (of highways), and as to legality and form by the attorney general, and be deposited with the secretary of state. * * *” (Words in parenthesis the writer’s.)

Finding said bond to have been properly executed in accordance with the above statutory provisions, I am hereby approving it as to form, and returning it to you herewith.
