## Narrative:

On Monday, April 12, 2021, at approximately 1741 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent Jim Mulford (SA Mulford) interviewed Paula Rose (Rose) in response to an Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) that occurred earlier this date at Mount Carmel St. Ann's Hospital in Westerville, OH. An altercation happened between Miles Jackson (Jackson) and officers from the Columbus Division of Police, Westerville Police, and St. Ann's Security Department. Jackson died as a result of gunshot wounds from this incident. The purpose of the interview was to obtain all relevant information of the incident known or observed by this individual.

This interview was audio recorded, and a copy of the recording was saved electronically within the case file. Please refer to the recording for specific quotes. The following is a summation of the interview.

Rose explained she is an ER LPN at St. Ann's and was assigned to Zone #3. She worked from 1000 hours to 2200 hours this date. She had no direct contact with Jackson during her shift.

Prior to the incident, Rose was standing at the nurse station adjacent to the incident location with a hallway separating. She heard three gunshots, lots of yelling, and then several more gunshots. She began moving patience from her area for safety.

Rose did not witness any of the incident, and had no further information.
