Dear Sir:

Under date of May 11 you submitted for my examination a written petition bearing over one hundred names proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Ohio by the enactment of a new section to be known as Article II, Section 11. The full text of said proposed section, which deals with the so-called "Davis F.E.P.C. Bill", together with a purported summary of the same, has been submitted by you.

Upon examination of the text of said proposed section and said purported summary, I am of the opinion that said purported summary is not in fact a summary as required by Section 4785-175 of the General Code, and further that said purported summary is not a fair and truthful summary of the proposed constitutional amendment, and for such reason I am unable to make the certification requested by you.
