On Tuesday, November 18th, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Aja Chung (SA Chung) received the items listed below from BCI Crime Scene Technician (CST) Amy Cruet (CST Cruet). At the request of SA Chung, CST Cruet retrieved evidence from the Montgomery County Coroner relating to the on-going officer involved critical incident that involved Christopher Lindner (Lindner), the Ohio State Highway Patrol, and West Union Police Department.

SA Chung photographed and repackaged with original packaging the following items:

Item 1: Clothing worn by Lindner: Camouflage heavy jacket, Nike camouflage jacket, black shirt, tan pants, pair of tennis shoes, and socks.

Item 2: Autopsy collections: Oral and rectal swabs, fingernail scrapings, hair samples, blood card, and fingerprints.

Item 3: Five plastic vials that contained projectiles recovered from Lindner's autopsy.

Item 4: Personal items: necklaces, passport, two one-dollar bills, two rings, and foam ear plugs.

Item 3 was submitted to the BCI Laboratory at 1350 hours.

Items 1, 2, and 4 were submitted to the major case evidence locker at 1510 hours.
