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APPROVAL—RESERVOIR LAND LEASE IN FAIRFIELD COUNTY FOR
THE RIGHT TO USE AND OCCUPY FOR BOATHOUSE AND DOCK-
LANDING PURPOSES—JACK EXENKAMPER.

COLUMBUS, OHIO, December 20, 1934.

HON. EARL H. HANEFELD, *Director, Department of Agriculture, Columbus, Ohio.*

DEAR SIR:—This is to acknowledge the receipt of a communication over the signature of the Chief of the Bureau of Inland Lakes and Parks, submitting for my examination and approval a reservoir land lease executed by the Conservation Commissioner to one Jack Exenkamper of No. 10 East Lynn Street, Columbus, Ohio. This lease, which is one for a term of fifteen (15) years, and which provides for an annual rental of nine dollars (\$9.00), payable semi-annually, leases and demises to the lessee above named the right to use and occupy for boathouse and docklanding purposes only, the following reservoir property at Buckeye Lake, being the Southeast Quarter of Section 28, Town 17, Range 18, Fairfield County, Ohio, and being that portion of the easterly part of Lot No. 7, north of the Summerland Beach Road, that is described as follows:

Commencing at an iron pin at the southeast corner of Lot No. 7; thence northerly along the easterly line of said Lot, 49 feet to the northeasterly corner thereof; thence westerly, 16 feet, to a mark on the stone retaining wall; thence southerly, 52 feet, to an iron pin in the northerly line of the Summerland Beach Road; thence easterly along the Summerland Beach Road, 21 feet to the place of beginning.

Upon examination of this lease I find that the same has been properly executed by the Conservation Commissioner on behalf of the state of Ohio and by Jack Exenkamper, the lessee therein named. I further find upon examination of the provisions of this lease and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained, that the same are in conformity with section 471, General Code, under the authority of which these leases are executed, and with other statutes relating to leases of this kind.

I am, therefore, approving this lease as to legality and form as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon the lease and the duplicate and triplicate copies thereof, all of which are herewith returned.
