On July 24, 2022 at approximately 1744 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Ryan Scheiderer conducted a neighborhood canvass in the area of 1132 Ashwood Drive, South Charleston (Clark County), Ohio, regarding the July 24, 2022 Officer-Involved Critical Incident (OICI) between multiple law enforcement agencies and the resident of 1132 Ashwood Drive, Cole White (White).
