**Narrative:**

On July 5, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Jon Lieber (Lieber) received records previously requested from the Youngstown Police Department (YPD). The records received included the body-worn camera (BWC) videos of the YPD officers that were on scene at [REDACTED], Youngstown, OH at the time of the officer-involved critical incident on June 13, 2024. This report will detail Officer Tony Kaleugher's (Kaleugher) BWC video.

Note that the video times referenced in this report will refer to the elapsed time of the video.

Officer Kaleugher's BWC video is 41 minutes and 39 seconds in duration. The video begins showing Kaleugher sitting in a vehicle. At 00:20, Kaleugher exited the vehicle. The front of the residence at [REDACTED], Youngstown, OH can be seen [00:21].

No sound can be heard until 00:29. At that time, a female voice can be heard (likely [REDACTED]). For additional information as to what [REDACTED] said, refer to the report titled "2024-07-29: YPD [REDACTED] BWC review." At 00:32, two gunshots are heard. A male voice ([REDACTED]) said, "Fuck, down, down, down." See screenshot below taken as the first gunshot was heard.

Multiple additional gunshots are heard as Kalaugher moved to the steps of the front porch. At 00:39, Kaleugher radioed "207 shots fired." The last gunshot was heard at 00:38. Kaleugher walked onto the porch and stood behind [REDACTED]. See screenshot below.

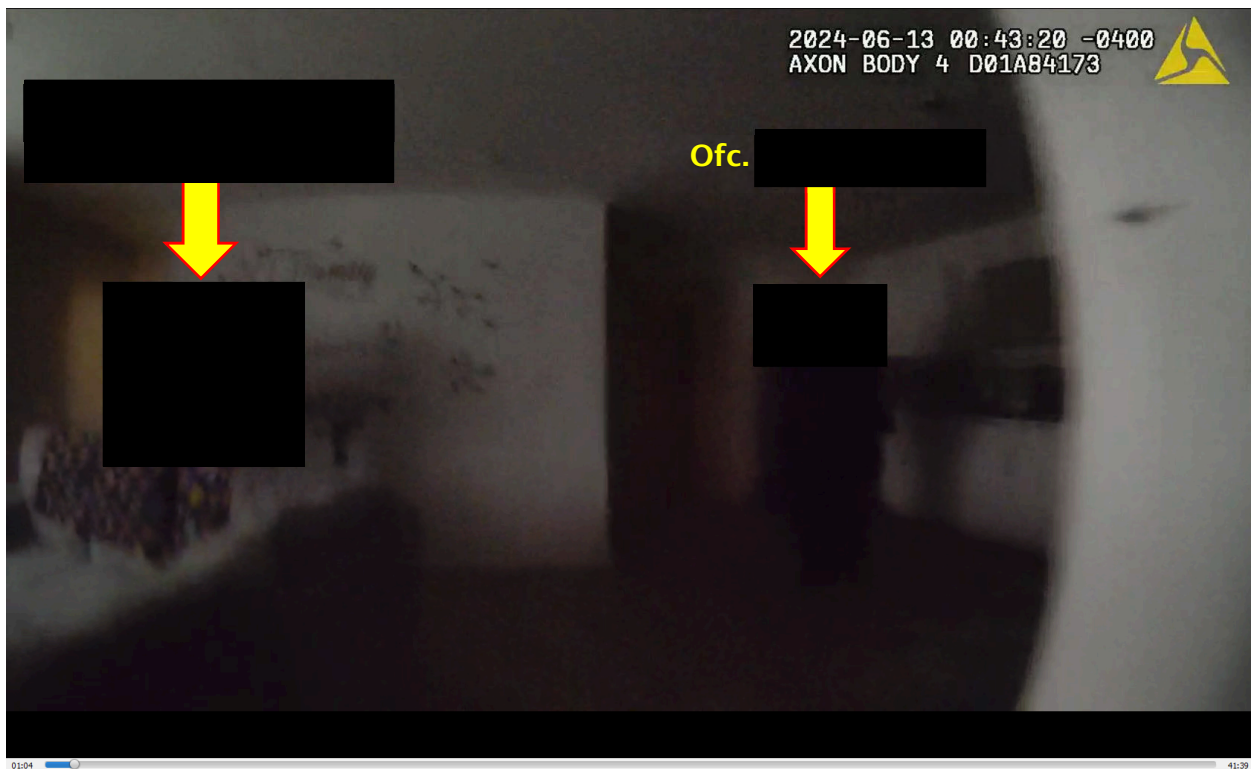

Kaleugher then left the porch and began to go around the side of the residence. At 00:49, Kaleugher said, "Wha, is he down?" [REDACTED] responded, "I don't know." Kaleugher made it a little more than halfway to the rear of the residence and at 00:56 said, "Ok, he's down." Kaleugher then proceeded to the front door and entered the residence. See screenshot below taken at 01:04 after Kaleugher entered the residence. At this time [REDACTED] can be heard saying to [REDACTED], "I'm sorry, I'm sorry mom."

At 01:13, [REDACTED] said "He's still breathing, still breathing." At 01:17, [REDACTED] said "Get the gun, get the gun, get the gun, get the gun. I got him covered, I got him covered. Get the gun out of his fucking hand." At 01:20, Kaleugher picked up a pistol lying near Mathue O'Malley (O'Malley). See screenshot below taken at 01:21.

At 01:29, as Kaleugher exited the front door with the pistol, Rodriguez said that she had a med kit in her car. Kaleugher replied "Go ahead and grab it, I got the gun." At 01:48, Kaleugher set the pistol in the rear trunk area of a police vehicle. See screenshot below.

Kaleugher re-entered the residence and proceeded to the basement. The basement floor appeared wet and the sound of water could be heard hitting the floor. At 02:19, as Kaleugher returned to the main floor, another officer (not [REDACTED] or Rodriguez) can be seen in the kitchen area and moving toward the rear bedroom.

At 02:40, [REDACTED] said "I think I got shot." Kaleugher looked at the wound. See screenshot below taken at 02:46.

Kaleugher remained in the residence near [REDACTED]. At 08:33, [REDACTED] was moved from the residence and relocated outside to a police vehicle. At 09:09, [REDACTED] began to speak to Kaleugher and Officer Nico Rodriguez (Rodriguez) about what lead up to the police being called to the residence. For additional information on [REDACTED] statement refer to the report titled "2024-07-30: YPD Officer Nico Rodriguez BWC review."

At 09:48, an ambulance pulled on the street in front of the residence. At 11:25, Kaleugher was standing with a group of officers. He then muted his BWC. At 13:56, sound can again be heard. At 20:31, the sound was again muted. At 21:34, sound can again be heard. At 31:58, Kaleugher said to another officer that due to the circumstances he grabbed the subject's (Mathue O'Malley) gun without gloves on and he did not make it safe (unload the gun).

At 34:39, the BWC is muted. The BWC remained muted through the remainder of the video.

At 41:39, the video ends.
