APPROVAL, CONTRACT BETWEEN STATE OF OHIO AND STATE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, OF COLUMBUS, OHIO, FOR CONSTRUCTION AND COMPLETION OF COTTAGE FOR INFIRM WOMEN, COLUMBUS STATE HOSPITAL, AT COST OF \$94,154.00—SURETY BOND EXECUTED BY THE AMERICAN GUARANTY COMPANY.

Dear Sir:—

You have submitted for my approval a contract between the State of Ohio, acting by the Department of Highways and Public Works, and State Construction Company, of Columbus, Ohio. This contract covers the construction and completion of cottage for infirm women, Columbus State Hospital, and calls for an expenditure of \$94,154.00.

You have submitted the certificate of the Director of Finance to the effect that there are unencumbered balances legally appropriated in a sum sufficient to cover the obligations of the contract.
