On 06/24/25, I was advised by dispatch of a suicidal male. It was reported that the therapist for Patrick Kerr was concerned because he had sent a picture of a gun in his car and that he was going to kill himself. The call came in at 1040 hours. It was reported by dispatch that the suspect vehicle, a Ford bearing license plate KNM1437 hit [REDACTED] on Pearl at Wesley at 1035 hours. I was on Pearl near W. 130th when the call came in. I advised dispatch that I would start looking.

Ptl. Onysyk #36 radioed that he had the suspect vehicle and was following it. I activated my lights and sirens because of my distance from Ptl. Onysyk #36. This was before Ptl. Onysyk #36 attempted to stop the vehicle. I travelled northeast on Pearl. I turned north onto Stumph. I was north on Stump at Huffman when Ptl. Onysek #36 attempted to stop the suspect vehicle. I was north on Stumph at Apache when Ptl. Onysek #36 radioed that the suspect vehicle was not stopping.

On Stumph, south of Snow, is when the fleeing vehicle came into my dash camera view. I was the third vehicle in the pursuit. At 10:48 hours (6197 Dash 6158 1-3) I radioed for Ptl. Felkonis #63 to take over the radio traffic because he was the second vehicle in the pursuit. I radioed that I was the third vehicle in the pursuit. Shortly after, while on Chevrolet Blvd, I radioed Sgt. Deily #62 asking if we were to continue or abort the pursuit of the suicidal male. Sgt. Deily #62 responded to continue.

I continued north on Chevrolet Blvd and then east on Brookpark Road. I continued north on Tiedeman. Ptl. Onysyk #36 radioed that the suspect vehicle had crashed on Tiedeman at I-480. Ptl. Onysyk #36 then radioed that the driver had a gun to his head.

I arrived and deployed my rifle. I observed two other vehicles that were involved in the crash. At one point during the incident, a male exited one of the vehicles and walked north along Tiedeman. I took up a position with Ptl. Onysyk #36 and Ptl. Felkonis #63. I was unable to see inside the vehicle due to the tinted glass and where I was standing. The driver, Patrick Kerr, smashed out a portion of his windows. He later smashed out his vehicle windows because of the high heat.

During the next almost two hours, I primarily spoke with Patrick Kerr. I took up several different positions during the incident. Kerr almost continually had a handgun pointed to his head. I observed him place a bottle of pills to his mouth as if he was eating them. I observed him smoke something. I observed him vomit, presumably because of the pills he had ingested. Due to the high heat, he wanted some water. I was able to throw to him several bottles of water. He asked to speak to his ex-wife and to a priest. Despite exhaustive negotiations, Kerr refused to give up his handgun and surrender.

Around 1245 hours, I was ordered off the scene and I returned to the city. I was in cruiser 6197. I added my body camera and dash camera footage to this report. My body camera (6158 BC 1-3) was able to view my cruiser's speedometer during the pursuit. My highest speed on Stumph Rd. was 67 mph. My highest speed on Chevrolet Blvd. was 81 mph. My highest speed on Brookpark Rd. was 75 mph. My highest speed on Tiedeman was 73 mph.



On 6-24-25 dispatch advised PHPD road units that per Rocky River PD they received a call from a therapist that stated her client SUB Patrick Kerr sent her a picture of a gun in his car and he was suicidal. Dispatch updated PHPD units that the SUB's vehicle a Ford pickup truck (Ohio listing KNM 1437) had just recently just hit on the Flock camera on Pearl and Wesley which is near the Parma and Parma Heights border. Ptl Onysyk advised dispatch that he was now behind the SUB's vehicle and was requesting other units before trying to initiate a traffic stop.

I left from station and caught up to Ptl. Onysyk northbound on Stumph Rd. just north of Big Creek Apartment complex. As I got close to Ptl. Olynyk's location he activated his emergency lights and sirens on his cruiser and attempted to stop the black Ford truck but it did not stop. The truck began to flee from Ptl. Onysyk at a high rate of speed and travel north on Stumph. I joined the pursuit as the second marked police vehicle (6190) and shortly afterwards Ptl. Molnar joined in as the 3rd marked police vehicle.

The SUB's truck continued to travel north on Stumph and traveled from the curb lane into the through lane and then back into the curb lane as he approached snow road and continued north onto Chevy Blvd. while traveling through a red light at the intersections of Stumph and Snow Road at a high rate of speed. The Ford then continued north onto Chevrolet Blvd. with his speeds now approaching 75 to 80 mph in a posted 35 mph zone.

At the intersection of Chevrolet Blvd and Brookpark Road the SUB's vehicle made a right hand turn onto Brookpark Road and was now traveling East on Brookpark Road with approximate speeds of 80 mph in a posted 35 mph zone with moderate traffic and the road conditions were dry. At the intersection of Brookpark and Tiedeman Road the SUB's vehicle made a left hand turn and now began to travel north on Tiedeman and continued to travel at a high rate of speed. Once the SUB's vehicle crossed over the top of the 480 bridge it struck 2 vehicles which disabled all 3 vehicles. The SUB's black Ford truck was now facing perpendicular to our patrol vehicles and the driver's side door was facing our patrol vehicles.

Ptl. Onysyk who was already out of his patrol vehicle near the rear, informed myself and Ptl. Molnar that he could see the driver of the Ford was holding a gun. All three of us drew our weapons and took cover behind Ptl. Olynyk's cruiser. I updated dispatch about the crash and the driver of the Ford truck began to break out the front driver's side tinted window. After the driver broke out the windows we could clearly see that the driver was holding a black colored hand gun to his head and he refused to get out of the truck. Ptl. Molnar and Ptl. Onysyk began to communicate with the driver who was later identified as Patrick Kerr and they tried to verbally de-escalate the situation. After other tactical SWAT units arrived the scene was turned over to them.



On 06/24/2025 at approximately 1040 hours dispatch advised all the road units that Patrick Kerr sent his therapist a picture of a gun and said he was threatening suicide after being fired from his job. The therapist contacted Rocky River PD because they were concerned, he might follow through with the threat, and Rocky River contacted our dispatch. Dispatch also informed us that Kerr was driving a black Ford (OH Registration KNM1437), and it hit the FLOCK camera southbound on Pearl Rd at Weasley Dr.

I pulled out of the station into the southbound curb lane of Pearl Rd. in front of me was a black Ford (OH Registration KNM1437). I radioed to dispatch to confirm the registration with dispatch. No other officer was close, so I followed the vehicle, and it continued southbound on Pearl Rd. When we reached the intersection of Pearl Rd. and Stumph Rd. it made a right turn onto Stumph Rd. When it made its turn onto Stumph Rd. it turned into the through lane and not the curb lane making an improper turn. I followed the vehicle as it continued northbound on Stumph Rd. When it approached the intersection of Big Creek Parkway it changed lanes to the curb lane and then stopped for the red light. When the light turned green the vehicle again began traveling northbound on Stumph Rd. When we reached the intersection of Stumph Rd. and Apache Dr. I could see Ptl. Felkoins approaching my location in my review mirror. I turned on my overhead lights and siren to initiate a traffic stop on the vehicle. The vehicle did not stop and began to accelerate to speeds of approximately 40-50mph.

As I was pursuing the vehicle on Stumph Rd. it approached the intersection of Stumph Rd. and Snow Rd. The vehicle slowed down briefly for the red light then accelerated through the intersection. Stumph Rd. turns into Chevrolet Blvd north of the intersection of Snow Rd. The vehicle reached speeds of 75-80 as it traveled northbound on Chevrolet Blvd. While on Chevrolet Blvd near Gabriella Dr., the vehicle used the southbound lanes while traveling northbound to go around traffic. The vehicle then returned to the northbound lanes and used all the northbound lanes. When we approached the intersection of Chevrolet Blvd and Brookpark Rd. it made a right turn onto Brookpark Rd. The vehicle continued on Brookpark Rd. eastbound until it reached the BP (10300 Brookpark Rd.) at the intersection of Tiedman Rd. The vehicle then turned into the Brookpark Rd. entrance to the BP and went through the lot and exited onto Tiedman Rd. and began to travel northbound on Tiedman Rd. While on Tiedman Rd. The vehicle used the left turning lane near 5170 Tiedman Rd. to pass traffic briefly came back into the northbound lane to avoid a vehicle at Cascade Crossing and then went back into the turning lane to pass additional traffic. When the vehicle was north of the I-480 east entrance it returned to the northbound lanes and into the curb lane. At the intersection of the I-480 west exit and entrance ramps and Tiedman Rd. the light was red stopping the northbound traffic on Tiedman Rd. The vehicle used the curb lane and went through the intersection without stopping for the red light. The vehicle struck a white sedan that was making a left turn from the exit ramp of I-480 west to the Tiedman southbound lanes. I could not see the make or model of the white vehicle. I exited my vehicle and I could see the driver of the black Ford (later identified as Patrick Kerr) with a gun to his head. There was a third vehicle involved in the accident, but I was unable to see how it was involved from my position. I retreated to the rear of my vehicle and gave verbal orders to show me his hands, roll the window down, and drop the gun.

Ptl. Molnar took over speaking with Kerr. A few minutes later a male exited the white vehicle using the rear passenger window (07:05 dash cam 6192) and walked northbound away from the accident. Brooklyn officers were able to approach the third vehicle with a shield, and check it for occupants. They were not able to check the white vehicle due to Kerr being directly in front of it. A drone was put up to check the white vehicle, and we learned that there was still a male in the driver's seat. SEB officers utilized an armored vehicle and were able to extract the male from the white vehicle. Ptl. Molnar continued speaking with Kerr and I covered him



from various positions until SEB took over command of the scene.

When I returned to the station, I called Rocky River PD and they sent me a copy of their CAD call [REDACTED]. They also sent me the text and picture messages Kerr sent his therapist. They also advised me they were in the process of completing a report and would send it to me when it was completed.

**Interview**

at 1000 hours on 07/01/2025 Detective Wittasek #6121 and I met with Robert Vaughn, the owner of Robin Hood Roofing and Restoration. He was accompanied by his employee Mason Butler, and Administrative Manager Amy.

We asked them to describe Patrick Kerr's employment with them, and they told us he had been hired in early March of 2025. Kerr was previously employed at a different roofing company for over 7 years, but was fired from that employer and began working for Robinhood shortly after. They described his performance as slipping, and that he was causing a lot of extra work for other employees. Amy told us on Friday 06/20/2025 Kerr abruptly left the office in the middle of a team meeting without explanation. He was then a no-show for a disciplinary one on one meeting he was supposed to have with the managers and team leads.

Amy tried calling him on Tuesday 06/24/2025 around 1008 hours and when Kerr didn't answer, she left a message telling him he was terminated from their employment. Shortly after she left the message, she received a phone call from Rocky River Police Department informing her of the texts Kerr sent to his therapist, and advising her he may have a weapon with him. Shortly after the notification, she said Kerr called her and texted her with excuses for his absence and told her he was on his way into work right now for his one on one. Amy explicitly told Kerr not to come to the building, and didn't hear from him again.

Vaughn told us he has known Kerr for a long time, and considered him a friend. He told us he had begun to notice Kerr's work ethic and quality had begun to falter after Kerr's divorce began. He told us Kerr was a family man, and considered his marriage and children to be his entire life, and built his personality around being a family man. Vaughn told us when Kerr's wife divorced him, he lost everything that mattered to him, and in turn, lost his drive to live. Vaughn then told us he believed Kerr was coming off of a "massive cocaine bender". Vaughn informed us that Kerr made a statement to him that he was the subject in an alleged rape case. We asked him where the case was out of but none of the employees knew. Vaughn told us he believed the allegations were false as the alleged victim was a good friend of Kerr's ex-wife, and the allegations arose during their divorce. He told us Kerr never was a violent person, and could not have considered him doing anything like the events on 06/24 or any of the allegations in the rape case against him.

Vaughn told us on 06/24/2025 after Amy informed him, he was fired, he tried to call Kerr for an explanation of his actions. While he was speaking with Kerr, Vaughn was informed of the Rocky River PD notification, and also told Kerr not to come to the office. He told us Kerr was rambling on the phone call and wasn't making much sense about anything at all.

I asked them if Kerr had made any types of threats towards them after being fired, and they all told me no. Vaughn then told me that Kerr would often make comments to him that if he were to lose his divorce, he would just kill himself because there would be nothing left for him to live for. Vaughn said he didn't think much of it at the time, but then recalled Kerr would say things like that quite often.

Mason butler told us he would never have guess Kerr was capable of anything like the events of 06/24/2025 but also confirmed that Kerr would often make suicidal statements regarding his divorce.

Vaughn told us he believed Kerr possibly was struggling with drug addiction he was fighting due to his recent divorce. He also stated this type of violent behavior was not like Kerr, but also noted Kerr had been making statements some including suicide by cop when talking about his divorce. .
