Dear Sir:

You have submitted for my approval contract between the State of Ohio, acting by the Department of Highways and Public Works, and The Chuse Engine and Manufacturing Company, of Mattoon, Illinois. This contract covers the construction and completion of one 13x16 Simple Side Crank, non-releasing Corliss Engine, and one general electric type L. C., 5 K. W., 1150 R. P. M. exciter, in Power Plant, Miami University, Oxford, Ohio, and calls for an expenditure of \$6,510.00.

You have submitted the certificate of the Director of Finance to the effect that there are unencumbered balances legally appropriated in a sum sufficient to cover the obligations of the contract. There has further been submitted a contract bond upon which the American Surety Company of New York appears as surety, sufficient to cover the amount of the contract.
