GENTLEMEN: The above purchase of bonds appears to be part of four issues of bonds of the above city dated June 1, 1920.

The transcript relative to the fire bonds was approved by this office in an opinion rendered to the Teachers Retirement System under date of June 23, 1936, being Opinion No. 5740.

The transcript relative to the park bonds was approved by this office in an opinion rendered to the Teachers Retirement System under date of October 22, 1933, being Opinion No. 4822. The police department bonds were also approved in Opinion No. 4822.

I have examined the transcript of proceedings relative to the public bath house bonds, in the aggregate amount of \$100,000, dated June 1, 1920, bearing interest at the rate of 5½% per annum.

From this examination, in the light of the law under authority of which these bonds have been authorized, I am of the opinion that bonds issued under these proceedings constitute a valid and legal obligation of said city.
