Narrative:

On Thursday, April 15, 2021, the Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent Supervisor (SAS) Kevin Barbeau received Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives (ATF) Firearms Trace Report. This report was completed by ATF following an Officer-Involved Critical Incident (OICI) which occurred at St. Ann's Hospital (500 South Cleveland Ave, Westerville, Ohio) on Monday, April 12, 2021. It was learned Columbus Police Officers were taking Miles Jackson (involved individual) into custody at St. Ann's Hospital Emergency Department (ED) room. A struggle ensued and CPD officers and St. Ann's (armed) Security Officers discharged their duty weapons. Miles died from apparent gunshot wounds. A firearm was located during a search that reportability did not belong to any law enforcement officers on scene.

SAS Barbeau reviewed the attached report and noted the above mentioned firearm located was a SIG SAUER P365 pistol (SN: 66A606280). [REDACTED]

On Tuesday, April 20, 2021, SAS Barbeau received the attached ATF report involving the follow-up interview of Pappas. Pappas notified ATF agents the above firearm he purchased was stolen from his unsecured vehicle at an unknown time, see attached for additional details.
