DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval certain grants of easement, executed to the State of Ohio, by several property owners in Union and Clermont Counties, Ohio, conveying to the State of Ohio, for the purposes therein stated, certain tracts of land in said counties.

The grants of easement here in question, designated with respect to the number of the instrument, the location of the land by township and county, and the name of the grantor, are as follows:
