On Monday, April 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2024, as part of an ongoing officer critical incident, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (S/A) Aja Chung retrieved evidence from Whitehall Police Department (WPD) and the Franklin County Coroner's Office (FCCO).

At 0845 hours, S/A Chung met with WPD Sergeant (Sgt.) Dustin Willis (Sgt. Willis) at WPD to retrieve items from Mount Carmel Hospital East (6001 East Broad Street, Columbus, OH). S/A Chung was advised items were given to the WPD officer assigned to stay with the deceased until the FCCO came to transport the body for autopsy. WPD Sgt. Willis further stated he was uncertain about the contents of the sealed evidence bag.

At 0915 hours, S/A Chung then traveled to the Franklin County Coroner's Office at the above listed activity location and retrieved the evidence collected from the autopsy.

For ease of reference, Mount Carmel Hospital East was designated as Scene 4 and the Franklin County Coroner's Office was designated as Scene 5. The items collected from both scenes were transported to BCI offices where they were photographed, labeled, and repackaged by S/A Chung as follows:

## Scene 4

- Item 1: Twelve (12) 9mm WIN cartridges and one clear knotted plastic bag corner with original packaging.
- Item 2: Money \$719.00
- Item 3: Clothing jeans, shirt, boxers, pair of socks, and a pair of Nike shoes with original packaging.
- Item 4: CD containing photos (photos uploaded to matrix).

## Scene 5

- Item 1: CD containing photos (photos uploaded to matrix)
- Item 2: Alfaromunoz blood card and fingerprints.

All items were submitted to the BCI Major Crimes temporary evidence locker #1 at 1100 hours.

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
