On Tuesday, September 16th, 2025, the Springfield Police Department (SPD) requested the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) with an officer involved critical incident. It was reported SPD [REDACTED] conducted a traffic stop on a silver pick-up truck for speeding, and the driver and sole occupant fled the traffic stop on foot. [REDACTED] reportedly gave chase down an alley and deployed his taser that made effective contact. The driver, identified as Patrick Foley (Foley), suffered a head injury that required being life flighted to a hospital. Due to Foley's condition, SPD requested BCI Crime Scene Unit (CSU) to process the scene and BCI Force Investigation Unit (FIU) to conduct the investigation. BCI Special Agent (SA) Aja Chung (SA Chung) was assigned to SPD's request for assistance.

Scene 1

SA Chung arrived at the scene and met with SPD crime scene officers Byron and Anderson, who provided her with further information necessary to process the scene. At approximately 1440 hours SA Chung documented the scene through photography. South Isabella St. between W. Clark St. and W. Pleasant St. was cordoned off with yellow police tape. The alleyway where the incident occurred also had yellow tape securing the area. The dirt alleyway consisted of overgrown brush and fencing from the surrounding houses on W. Clark St. and W. Pleasant St. SA Chung further documented the scene with a 3D scanner.

It was decided the silver pick-up truck would be processed by SPD crime scene officers and was towed away from the scene.

SA Chung located five items of evidentiary value. The first two items located were tiny bright pink taser confetti's that were found at the beginning of the alley, near the wood telephone pole behind 522 S. Clark St. They were collected as item 1 and item 2. bloodstains located further east in the alley. Three long pieces of taser wire were collected as item 3. Blue eyeglass frames with missing lenses and a single eyeglass lens were located in the bloodstains. The eyeglass frames and single lens were packaged together as item 4. A white camouflage knife carabiner was observed near the eyeglass frames and collected as item 5.

SA Chung collected swabs of suspected blood from the three different bloodstains. They were labeled as items 6-8.

No other items of evidentiary value were located and SA Chung concluded processing the alleyway scene at approximately 1600 hours.

She then drove to Springfield Police Department to document SPD [REDACTED]. The hiatus between the two scenes was approximately 15 minutes due to drive time and the officer speaking to his union representative.

Scene 2

At 1615 hours, SA Chung photographed the front, back and both sides of SPD [REDACTED], who was dressed in his department issued uniform. His uniform consisted of a short sleeve shirt with SPD patches on both shoulders, an exterior ballistic vest, duty belt and dark colored battle dress uniform pants.

SA Chung collected [REDACTED] yellow Axon taser with a serial number: [REDACTED] and removed the battery. The taser was labeled as item 1. The two unfired taser cartridges in the taser were photographed only and returned to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] confirmed he deployed his taser one time and removed the taser probe from Foley's person. SA Chung received the deployed taser cartridge (item 2) and the taser probe (item 3).

No other items were collected from [REDACTED] or SPD representative.

SA Chung concluded her processing at 1715 hours.

The items collected from both scenes (11 total) were secured in the BCI Major Crimes locker #1 on September 17, 2025, at 1130 hours.
