APPROVAL—RESERVOIR LAND LEASE, STATE OF OHIO, THROUGH CONSERVATION COMMISSIONER WITH EMMA J. CONRAD, ST. MARYS, OHIO, TERM FIFTEEN YEARS, ANNUAL RENTAL, \$18.00, DESIGNATED PORTION, LAKE ST. MARYS, AUGLAIZE COUNTY, OHIO, RIGHT TO OCCUPY AND USE FOR COTTAGE SITE PURPOSES ONLY.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval a certain reservoir land lease in triplicate, executed by the State of Ohio, through you as Conservation Commissioner to Emma J. Conrad of St. Marys, Ohio.

By this lease, which is one for a term of fifteen years and which provides for an annual rental of \$18.00, there is leased and demised to the lessee above named, the right to occupy and use for cottage site purposes only, that portion of the outer slope of the easterly embankment of Lake St. Marys, that is included in the south-half of Lot No. 12, of embankment lots south of The Lake Erie and Western Railway right-of-way, and being part of the northwest quarter of Section 9, Town 6, South, Range 4 East, Auglaize County, Ohio, excepting therefrom twenty-five (25) feet off the east side of the State property for driveway purposes.

Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by you as Conservation Commissioner and by said lessee. I further find, upon consideration of the provisions of this lease and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained, that the same are in conformity with Section 471, General Code, under the authority of which this lease is executed, and with other statutory enactments relating to leases of this kind.
