Narrative:

As part of this investigation, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Ryan Emahiser requested from the Seneca County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) all reports, phone calls, and any other involvement reports regarding Blake Fleure (Blake). SCSO Chief Deputy Chuck Boyer provided SA Emahiser on May 6, 2024, with the following reports and audio files. Below is a brief synopsis of those reports and audio files. The full reports and audio files should be reviewed for a full comprehension of the actual details. All of these reports and audio calls have been uploaded to this case file, and attached to this report for review.

- Eric Fleure (Eric) 911 call to SCSO. On May 3, 2024, at 11:38 hours Eric called 911 to the SCSO advising that he had just spoken with his son Blake on the phone. Blake had cut his wrists and was possibly in the Tiffin area driving a red 2000 Chevy pickup. The SCSO dispatcher connected the call with Tiffin Police Department (TPD) dispatchers and Eric told the dispatcher that Blake frequents parking lots in Tiffin, and that Blake wasn't thinking right. Eric provided the dispatcher Blake's cell phone number (419) 455–4466, and personal information. Eric also advised that his wife was going to be looking for Blake in Tiffin as well. Eric provided his address and the dispatcher said they would be sending SCSO Deputies out to speak with Eric. The dispatcher advised Eric to contact SCSO if he had any additional information to provide regarding Blake. Call duration seven minutes and 14 seconds.
- SCSO call to Verizon for Exigent Phone Ping Location. On May 3, 2024, at 11:49 hours SCSO dispatcher Stacey Saylors called Verizon Security to obtain an emergency ping for Blake's cell phone and told Verizon Security the reason for the emergency ping was "life threatening." Verizon Security asked for more specific reasoning and the SCSO dispatcher Saylors advised "suicidal." After several minutes on hold, Verizon Security advised that they had the location of Blake's cell phone with a time stamp of 11:54 Hours, Latitude 41.118.044 and Longitude –83.183.423 within a radius of 165 meters from that coordinate which is 75 South Sandusky Street in Tiffin. Toward the end of the call radio traffic on the SCSO dispatch radio channel can be heard with one of the

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- Deputies saying, "12 are you clear on the city's traffic shots fired?" The call was terminated, and the duration was six minutes and 29 seconds.
- SCSO call to TPD asking about subject down. Call duration 16 seconds at 11:57 hours, SCSO only inquiring about TPD being out with the red 2000 Chevy pickup truck, and TPD dispatcher told SCSO that the only information she had was that "shots were fired."
- 911 call from Perry St. resident advising subject shot and inquire of ambulance. Call duration 33 seconds at 12:01 hours, female caller advising that there was a man shot in front of her residence by the police and the female caller wanted to ensure that an ambulance was in route.
- SCSO call to TPD requesting to know status on Perry St. Call duration one minute and 39 seconds, at 12:02 hours. SCSO dispatcher advised that deputies were out with Eric, Blake's father, and were inquiring on the status of the situation. The TPD dispatcher did not have any additional information at that time.
- 24–1374 SCSO CAD Report. Prior SCSO call for service on 1/31/2024 at Fleure residence regarding Blake having a mental health episode.
- 24–1374 SCSO Incident Report. Prior SCSO call for service on 1/31/2024 at Fleure residence regarding Blake having a mental health episode and breaking things inside the Fleure residence. Deputies arrived at the residence and after some time were able to talk with Blake who told them that he hears demons that tell him to do things, and the demons tell Blake that he is "already dead." In the report Deputies documented that Blake has had mental health issues for several years, with things worsening prior to the report date. Blake ultimately agreed that he needed help and was transported by SCSO Deputies to the Tiffin Mercy Hospital.
- 24-6438 SCSO CAD Report. SCSO call for service on 5/3/2024 from Eric regarding Blake, and the above mentioned 911 calls.
- 24–6438 SCSO Incident Report. SCSO call for service on 5/3/2024 from Eric regarding Blake, and the above mentioned 911 calls. Prior to arriving at the Fleure residence, responding Deputies heard over TPD's channel that shots were fired involving the red Chevy truck reported to be driven by Blake. Upon arriving at the Fleure residence Eric told the Deputies that his wife Denise Fleure witnessed Blake being shot. Eric told Deputies that Blake did not appear to be "OK" earlier that morning, that Blake wanted to leave earlier in the day but that Eric talked Blake into staying home. Eric told Deputies that Blake eventually left the residence, and shortly after Blake texted Eric and told Eric that Blake was "hurting himself by cutting his wrists." Eric said at that time he called the SCSO for help. Eric told Deputies that Blake began having mental health issues around the Covid outbreak time period, that Blake had seen a counselor, but that nothing has helped Blake. Eric told Deputies that they did not feel the mental health professionals were helping Blake as they should have. Deputies transported Eric and another family member to the Tiffin Mercy Hospital ER where Blake was being taken to by Tiffin Fire and Rescue Division.



On the above date and time, Deputy Sprow and I were dispatched to 1765 N Cr 41 in Scipio Township for a disturbance. The complainant and mother, Denise Fleure called 911 after her 19-year-old son Blake Fleure was throwing and breaking items throughout the house.

Arriving on location, deputies were greeted by Denise. Denise allowed deputies into her residence. It was at that time; I observed a large amount of glass shattered onto the floor in multiple rooms on the first floor of Denise's residence. Blake was standing in the dining room and appeared with an accelerated appearance. Blake also appeared nervous and was not interested in speaking with law enforcement.

Speaking with Blake, Blake did not want to share what had happened inside the residence. Blake stated that its very complicated, when asked what was going on. Blake stated I understand your here to help but if I'm completely honest, I really wish my mom hadn't called you. Blake then mentioned that there is some bad stuff going on in his life right now.

Noticing that Blake was not wanting to talk with deputies or relay any information as to why the house was destroyed. I asked Blake if he was willing to talk to someone such as a counselor, Blake refused. Deputy Sprow and I then begin asking Blake different questions such as Blake's age and where Blake worked. Blake appeared to open up after those questions.

Blake then informed Deputy Sprow and I that he hears what appears to be demons such as the devil telling Blake what to do. It was mentioned that Blake has stated that the devil or this demon is telling Blake that he's already dead. The longer Deputy Sprow and I talked with Blake the more comfortable Blake was towards us.

Speaking with Denise also, we were informed that Blake has been having these types of outbursts for a couple of years but within the last couple of months it has gotten much worse. Denise informed that they have seek counseling while a recent visit to the Tiffin Mercy Hospital. Denise stated that she wished the hospital would've done more for Blake during that visit.

At that time, I made a phone call to Firelands and spoke with a counselor from the Sandusky office. The counselor that I spoke to informed me that she was talking with Denise prior to law enforcement's arrival. That call was terminated, and the counselor was not able to make contact with Denise. I then informed that the family was not happy with a recent visit to Tiffin Mercy. I was informed by Firelands if Blake was willing to go back to Tiffin Mercy, Firelands would contact the hospital with a request of recommendations.

Speaking back with Blake and Denise, Denise was informed of the conversation with Firelands. Blake agreed that he needed some help and that he would go back to the Tiffin Mercy.

Blake was then informed that I would be transporting him to the hospital. Denise stated that she would be enroute shortly but needed to make the house suitable for when the other family members came home.

Blake was then transported to the hospital without incident. Once at the hospital Blake was assessed by medical personnel and as at that time, turned over to hospital staff.

Incident was documented while wearing issued body camera, X2-5486.

The Seneca County Sheriff's Office received a call from an Eric Fleure of 1765 N CR 41, Tiffin, Ohio stating that he just received a text from his son, Blake Fleure, stating that he has cut his wrist.

Mr. Fleure stated that Blake would possibly be in Tiffin at a parking lot or park. He stated that his son just likes to park somewhere. Blake was driving a red Chevy pick-up. It was found that the Chevy pick-up was bearing Ohio RP HDP8749.

Deputy Cantu and I was then dispatched to the residence while Tiffin PD was informed to be on the lookout for the vehicle. Dispatch was also at this time making contact with Blake's cellphone provider to start "pinging" his cellphone location.

While enroute to the residence, I overheard Tiffin PD radio traffic that one of their units had located the red pick-up going west on W. Perry St. The Tiffin PD unit then conducted a traffic stop on the pick-up on W. Perry St. between Benner & Sandusky St. in an attempt to render first-aid. Almost immediately after the Tiffin PD unit called in the traffic stop, the officer transmitted "shots fired" twice.

By this time, I was north of the residence on CR 41 and Sgt. Best, who was working the traffic grant was getting close and about to signal out at the residence. I instructed Deputy Cantu to disregard coming to the residence and get to the city for the "shots fired."

When I pulled up to the residence, Mr. Fleure was sitting on the steps to the porch while Sgt. Best was standing speaking with him. Mr. Fleure was visibly distraught, yelling and crying off and on. While speaking with him, he (Mr. Fleure) informed me that his wife had watched their son get shot. I informed Mr. Fleure that we needed to get to his wife and son, I would take him to them.

While speaking with Mr. Fleure, he stated that Blake did not appear to be OK this morning. He stated that at one time Blake wanted to leave but he talked him into staying at home. He said Blake then eventually did leave and a short time later, he received the text from Blake saying he was hurting himself by cutting his wrists. Mr. Fleure said he then called us.

Mr. Fleure was then second guessing himself by saying what was he supposed to do, he had to call for help. He started saying that he got his son shot by calling for help. Sgt. Best and I were both trying to reassure him that he did the best thing he could have done and that any other parent would have done the same thing.

Mr. Fleure finally agreed to let me take him to his family members in the city. Sgt. Best and I went inside the residence with Mr. Fleure to make sure everything was good inside the house before we left.

I then informed dispatch that I was enroute to Tiffin Mercy ER with Mr. Fleure. I informed dispatch to call Mercy PD and inform them as what all has taken place and to be prepared. Deputy Cantu was also instructed to go to Tiffin Mercy ER for an additional unit for security purposes. Sgt. Best went as well.

While driving to the ER, Mr. Fleure gave me a little more background on Blake. I learned that Blake's mental illness first appeared around the COVID outbreak time. Mr. Fleure stated that they and his son have reached out and Blake has spoken with a counselor, but it is not helping. Mr. Fleure expressed numerous times throughout his concerns with the lack of help people get that suffer from mental illnesses which included his son. He stated that he does not believe that they, mental illness professionals are helping him like they should.

When I arrived at the hospital with Mr. Fleure, his wife, Tiffin PD, Officer Buetler and Deputy Cantu were already there in the ER waiting room. Mr. Fleure asked numerous times if he could go back into the ER to see his son. Tiffin Mercy personal was consoling and assisting the family.

Sqt. Best, Deputy Cantu and I then remained at the hospital to assist with the family and security.

When the ER doctor declared Blake to be deceased, I took over securing the body (Blake) until a Tiffin PD detective arrived.

Tiffin PD, Detective Nowak arrived at the ER and all units then went back into service.

I then went to the scene, 121 W Perry St. to speak with Tiffin PD, Chief Pauly. While at the scene, I relayed the information that I had learned from Mr. Fleure about his son's history and behavior earlier today before he had left his residence.

Information relayed and then I went back into service, nothing further...KPR

NARRATIVE

On the above date and time, Deputy Sprow and I were dispatched to 1765 N Cr 41 in Scipio Township for a disturbance. The complainant and mother, Denise Fleure called 911 after her 19-year-old son Blake Fleure was throwing and breaking items throughout the house.

Arriving on location, deputies were greeted by Denise. Denise allowed deputies into her residence. It was at that time; I observed a large amount of glass shattered onto the floor in multiple rooms on the first floor of Denise's residence. Blake was standing in the dining room and appeared with an accelerated appearance. Blake also appeared nervous and was not interested in speaking with law enforcement.

Speaking with Blake, Blake did not want to share what had happened inside the residence. Blake stated that its very complicated, when asked what was going on. Blake stated I understand your here to help but if I'm completely honest, I really wish my mom hadn't called you. Blake then mentioned that there is some bad stuff going on in his life right now.

Noticing that Blake was not wanting to talk with deputies or relay any information as to why the house was destroyed. I asked Blake if he was willing to talk to someone such as a counselor, Blake refused. Deputy Sprow and I then begin asking Blake different questions such as Blake's age and where Blake worked. Blake appeared to open up after those questions.

Blake then informed Deputy Sprow and I that he hears what appears to be demons such as the devil telling Blake what to do. It was mentioned that Blake has stated that the devil or this demon is telling Blake that he's already dead. The longer Deputy Sprow and I talked with Blake the more comfortable Blake was towards us.

Speaking with Denise also, we were informed that Blake has been having these types of outbursts for a couple of years but within the last couple of months it has gotten much worse. Denise informed that they have seek counseling while a recent visit to the Tiffin Mercy Hospital. Denise stated that she wished the hospital would've done more for Blake during that visit.

At that time, I made a phone call to Firelands and spoke with a counselor from the Sandusky office. The counselor that I spoke to informed me that she was talking with Denise prior to law enforcement's arrival. That call was terminated, and the counselor was not able to make contact with Denise. I then informed that the family was not happy with a recent visit to Tiffin Mercy. I was informed by Firelands if Blake was willing to go back to Tiffin Mercy, Firelands would contact the hospital with a request of recommendations.

NARRATIVE

The Seneca County Sheriff's Office received a call from an Eric Fleure of 1765 N CR 41, Tiffin, Ohio stating that he just received a text from his son, Blake Fleure, stating that he has cut his wrist.

Mr. Fleure stated that Blake would possibly be in Tiffin at a parking lot or park. He stated that his son just likes to park somewhere. Blake was driving a red Chevy pick-up. It was found that the Chevy pick-up was bearing Ohio RP HDP8749.

Deputy Cantu and I was then dispatched to the residence while Tiffin PD was informed to be on the lookout for the vehicle. Dispatch was also at this time making contact with Blake's cellphone provider to start "pinging" his cellphone location.

While enroute to the residence, I overheard Tiffin PD radio traffic that one of their units had located the red pick-up going west on W. Perry St. The Tiffin PD unit then conducted a traffic stop on the pick-up on W. Perry St. between Benner & Sandusky St. in an attempt to render first-aid. Almost immediately after the Tiffin PD unit called in the traffic stop, the officer transmitted "shots fired" twice.

By this time, I was north of the residence on CR 41 and Sgt. Best, who was working the traffic grant was getting close and about to signal out at the residence. I instructed Deputy Cantu to disregard coming to the residence and get to the city for the "shots fired."

When I pulled up to the residence, Mr. Fleure was sitting on the steps to the porch while Sgt. Best was standing speaking with him. Mr. Fleure was visibly distraught, yelling and crying off and on. While speaking with him, he (Mr. Fleure) informed me that his wife had watched their son get shot. I informed Mr. Fleure that we needed to get to his wife and son, I would take him to them.

While speaking with Mr. Fleure, he stated that Blake did not appear to be OK this morning. He stated that at one time Blake wanted to leave but he talked him into staying at home. He said Blake then eventually did leave and a short time later, he received the text from Blake saying he was hurting himself by cutting his wrists. Mr. Fleure said he then called us.

Mr. Fleure was then second guessing himself by saying what was he supposed to do, he had to call for help. He started saying that he got his son shot by calling for help. Sgt. Best and I were both trying to reassure him that he did the best thing he could have done and that any other parent would have done the same thing.

Mr. Fleure finally agreed to let me take him to his family members in the city. Sgt. Best and I went inside the residence with Mr. Fleure to make sure everything was good inside the house before we left.

I then informed dispatch that I was enroute to Tiffin Mercy ER with Mr. Fleure. I informed dispatch to call Mercy PD and inform them as what all has taken place and to be prepared. Deputy Cantu was also instructed to go to Tiffin Mercy ER for an additional unit for security purposes. Sgt. Best went as well.

While driving to the ER, Mr. Fleure gave me a little more background on Blake. I learned that Blake's mental illness first appeared around the COVID outbreak time. Mr. Fleure stated that they and his son have reached out and Blake has spoken with a counselor, but it is not helping. Mr. Fleure expressed numerous times throughout his concerns with the lack of help people get that suffer from mental illnesses which included his son. He stated that he does not believe that they, mental illness professionals are helping him like they should.

When I arrived at the hospital with Mr. Fleure, his wife, Tiffin PD, Officer Buetler and Deputy Cantu were already there in the ER waiting room. Mr. Fleure asked numerous times if he could go back into the ER to see his son. Tiffin Mercy personal was consoling and assisting the family.

Sgt. Best, Deputy Cantu and I then remained at the hospital to assist with the family and security.

When the ER doctor declared Blake to be deceased, I took over securing the body (Blake) until a Tiffin PD detective arrived.

Tiffin PD, Detective Nowak arrived at the ER and all units then went back into service.

I then went to the scene, 121 W Perry St. to speak with Tiffin PD, Chief Pauly. While at the scene, I relayed the information that I had learned from Mr. Fleure about his son's history and behavior earlier
