## SUMMARY:

On Thursday, October 12, 2023 BCI Crime Scene Technician Michael Rostocil #204 assisted the Youngstown Police Department with the processing of an indoor crime scene located at 4312 Helena Avenue, Youngstown, Ohio regarding an officer-involved critical incident (Refer to IRW-3 for scene processing details).

## **DETAILS:**

On Thursday, October 12, 2023 at 1040hrs, CST Rostocil was contacted by Special Agent Supervisor Ed Lulla and was requested to assist the Youngstown Police Department with the processing of an indoor crime scene regarding an officer-involved critical incident. CST Rostocil arrived on scene at 4312 Helena Avenue, Youngstown, Ohio at 1230 hours and met with BCI Special Agents Larry Hootman and John Tingley.

All items of evidence (#1-12) were turned over to CST Rostocil from SA Hootman. An inventory/receipt form was filled out and signed by SA Hootman and CST Rostocil. At 1445 hours, CST Rostocil transported all evidence to 4055 Highlander Pkwy, Richfield, Ohio (Ohio BCI - Richfield Office). At 1615 hours, CST Rostocil secured Items #1-10 into temporary evidence storage locker #4. Items #11-12 were secured in the drying room.
