Narrative:

On 06/29/2022, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Tiffany Vollmer (Vollmer) interviewed Firefighter Lieutenant (Lt.) Chris Lauck (Lauck) of the Lima Fire Department (LFD), relative to the officer-involved shooting which took place on 06/21/2022. The interview took place at Lima Central Fire 433 S. Main Street, Lima, Ohio. The purpose of the interview was to obtain all relevant information of the incident known or observed by this individual regarding their response to the incident scene. The following is a summary of the interview which was recorded and attached to the case file:

Lt. Lauck advised he has been with the fire department for approximately 28 years and is a firefighter EMT (Emergency Medical Technician). Lt. Lauck said he was dispatched to a shooting involving a deputy at Second and Sugar Street. Upon arrival, he started walking towards the rear of 1107 E. Second Street; where a law enforcement officer told him there was a DOA (Dead on arrival) and an officer towards the back of the property. Lt. Lauck instructed Firefighters Hammons and Frew to medically assist the deputy. Lt. Lauck then organized the LFD trucks that were coming into the area.

Lt. Lauck did not see movement with the subject he was told was deceased. Once he was told the subject was DOA, the focus was on helping the deputy.
