APPROVAL, CONTRACT BETWEEN THE STATE OF OHIO AND RONAN AND INGLESON, COLUMBUS, OHIO, FOR INSTALLATION OF EQUIPMENT FOR TRAINING SCHOOL BUILDING, KENT STATE NORMAL SCHOOL, KENT, OHIO, AT AN EXPENDITURE OF \$1,350.00.

DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my approval a contract between the State of Ohio, acting by the Department of Highways and Public Works, and Ronan and Ingleson, a partnership, Columbus, Ohio. This contract covers the complete architectural and engineering services in connection with the selection and installation of certain equipment for the training school building at Kent State Normal School, Kent, Ohio, and calls for an expenditure of one thousand three hundred and fifty dollars (\$1,350.00).
