GENTLEMEN:

RE: Bonds of the City of Youngstown, Mahoning County, Ohio, \$10,000.00.

I have examined the transcript of proceedings relative to the above bonds purchased by you. These bonds comprise part of an issue of street widening bonds in the aggregate amount of \$1,845,000, dated October 1, 1938, and bearing interest at the rate of  $3\frac{1}{2}\%$  per annum.
