By the above grants there is conveyed to the State of Ohio, certain lands described therein, for the sole purpose of using said lands for public fishing grounds, and to that end to improve the waters or water courses passing through and over said lands.

Upon examination of the above instruments, I find that the same have been executed and acknowledged by the respective grantors in the manner provided by law and am accordingly approving the same as to legality and form, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed thereon, all of which are herewith returned.

A.P.P.R.O.V.A.L.—CANAL LAND LEASE EXECUTED BY THE STATE OF OHIO TO THE EAST OHIO GAS COMPANY OF CLEVELAND, OHIO.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval a canal land lease in triplicate executed by you as Superintendent of Public Works, acting for and in the name of the State of Ohio, to The East Ohio Gas Company of Cleveland, Ohio.

This lease, which is one for a stated term of fifteen years and which provides for an annual rental of \$12.00, is a renewal of a lease granted to The East Ohio Gas Company under date of October 2, 1927, and by its terms there is leased and demised to the lessee above named the right to lay and maintain an eighteen (18") inch gas pipe line under the Ohio and Erie Canal in Cuyahoga County at a point two hundred feet east of what is known as "Eight Mile Aqueduct," being at or near Station 340 of G. F. Silliman's survey of said canal.

This lease is one executed under the general authority conferred upon you by Section 13965, General Code, with respect to canal land
