EASEMENTS, PUBLIC FISHING GROUNDS, TO STATE BY  
THIRTEEN GRANTORS, LANDS, FLORENCE TOWNSHIP,  
ERIE COUNTY.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval certain grants of easement, executed to the State of Ohio by several property owners in Florence Township, Erie County, Ohio, conveying to the State of Ohio, for the purposes therein stated, certain tracts of land in said township and county.
