I have examined the transcript relative to the above purchase of bonds, which transcript is incomplete in various respects.

The transcript contains no certificate of membership of the officials of the city having to do with the authorization and issuance of these bonds during the time the proceedings took place, nor is there included therein proper evidence of the called meeting of council of May 11, 1937. The transcript contains no copy of the ballot submitted to the electors authorizing the issuance of these bonds and is deficient in other respects.

In view of the fact that this office has been unsuccessful in securing the necessary data to complete this transcript, the same is hereby disapproved and you are advised not to purchase this issue.
