DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my approval contract between the State of Ohio, acting by the Department of Highways and Public Works, and The Huffman-Wolfe Company, a corporation of Columbus, Ohio. This contract relates to the completion of the heating and plumbing of the administration building of the Ohio State University, and calls for an expenditure of \$31,843.00.
