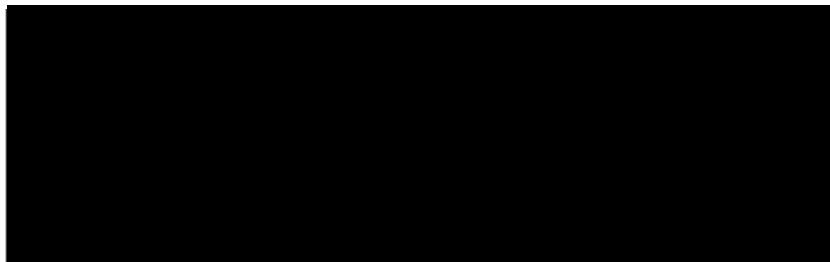

**Narrative:**

On May 9, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Andrew Harasimchuk (Harasimchuk) completed a Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) eTrace on the following firearm: a SCCY Industries, LLC. Model CPX-2, 9mm firearm, bearing a serial number of 723802. This firearm was recovered in the front yard of 4802 James Road, North Ridgeville, Ohio 44039. This firearm was reportedly possessed by and possibly used by Jason Norris.

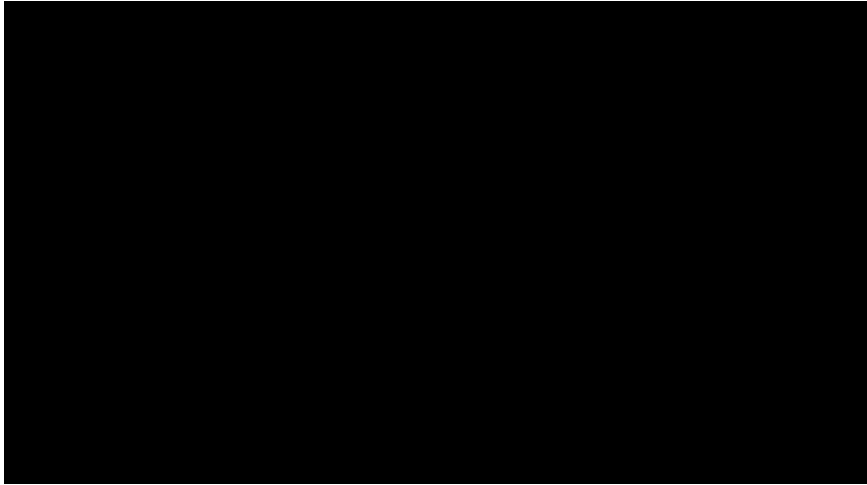
