DEAR SIR:—You have submitted two bonds, each in the penal sum of \$5,000, with surety as indicated, to cover the faithful performance of the duties of the officials as hereinafter listed:

Elmer Hilty, Deputy Director in charge of the Bureau of Construction, Department of Highways—New Amsterdam Casualty Company.

I. R. Ault, Resident Division Deputy Director in Division No. 3—Glens Falls Indemnity Company.

The above mentioned bonds are evidently executed pursuant to the provisions of sections 1181, 1182 and 1182-3, General Code. Such sections provide, so far as pertinent:

“Sec. 1181. The director (of highways) shall also appoint four deputy directors * * *. One of these deputy directors shall be experienced in road construction and, acting under the direction of the first assistant director, shall have supervision of all matters pertaining to road construction and improvement on the state highway system as provided for in this act. * * * The director (of highways) shall require each deputy director to give bond in the sum of five thousand dollars, conditioned for the faithful performance of his duties, with sureties to the approval of the state highway director.”
