APPROVAL, CONTRACT BETWEEN STATE OF OHIO AND THE RICE-JONES COMPANY, CLEVELAND, OHIO, TO CONSTRUCT CONCRETE DAM ACROSS TUSCARAWAS RIVER NEAR LONG LAKE, SUMMIT COUNTY, OHIO, AT AN EXPENDITURE OF \$10,676.04.

DEAR SIR:—You have resubmitted for my approval a contract in triplicate between the State of Ohio by George F. Schlesinger, Director of Highways and Public Works, and the Rice-Jones Company of Cleveland, Ohio. This contract covers the construction and completion of a reenforced concrete dam across the Tuscarawas River near Long Lake, Summit county, Ohio, and calls for an expenditure of \$10,676.04.

In opinion Number 677, dated June 29th, 1927, the contract aforesaid was returned to you without my approval endorsed thereon, for the reasons therein pointed out. This contract has been rewritten and re-executed and now contains a provision for the completion of the work therein contemplated on a certain definite date. Provision has also been made for a forfeiture of the sum of \$15.00 for each day that such work is carried over the time specified, all in compliance with Section 2331, General Code.

You have also submitted evidence of the awarding of the contract, and proof that publication was made of notice to contractors of the time and place, when and where bids would be received for the project under consideration, and all other matters for the proper approval of this contract by me.

Now finding said contract and bond in proper legal form I have this day noted my approval thereon and return the same herewith to you together with all other data submitted in this connection.
