FOLLOW-UP REPORT

TITLE TO READ: Homicide/FIT/Felonious Assault on P.O. X2/ Agg. Robbery Firearm/ Police Intervention/ Shooting Foreign Agency/ Abated by Death/ Gun Confiscation X2.

Sir, On 2 June 2022, while assigned to Crime Scene Unit #8119, I (Det. Troy E. Edge#656) responded to a radio assignment for a FIT call up c/w an officer involved shooting at 3495 E.98th street. Upon my arrival, I was met by Sgt. Schneider#9237 and Sgt. Lower#9248 who walked me to apartment #703 where the incident occurred to. I began to assess the area, find my focal point and determine what equipment I would need to process the scene. Once inside the apartment I observed the apartment in complete disarray. The entire apartment had water on the floor. There was blood spatter and blood smears throughout the entire apartment. There was a firearm on the floor of the north bedroom, a taser, cartridge casings and garbage throughout the entire apartment. I looked off the balcony and saw a large pile of debris that appeared to be thrown out of the apartment and onto the front lawn. I began to document the scene by placing placards next to the items of interest, taking notes and photographing the evidence. At this time, I was joined on scene by Crime Scene Unit# 8116 (Det. Emerick # 1908 and Det. Hale # 1138) who assisted at the scene searching for evidence. After members of the Homicide Unit were done searching the scene and taking measurements I collected the evidence so that it could be analyzed.

SCENE: This scene was a high rise apartment building (CMHA) property in apartment #703, located in the City of Cleveland, known as Union Square.

ON SCENE: Crime Scene Unit Detectives: Edge#656/Emerick #1908/Hale#1138/Sgt. Rini#9051. Homicide Unit Detectives: Diaz#1001/Legg#2198/Schultz#508/Bauhof#1637/Sgt. Reese#9266/Sgt.Gomez#9135. There were also multiple officers from CMHA and CPD. See Crime Scene Log for additional personnel on scene.

PHOTOS: (CS#177718)- A total of 133 photos were taken of this scene which was a CMHA apartment building (Unit#703). On the exterior photos were taken of the front of the building, the front door entrance, the apartment building logo sign, a large pile of debris in the front lawn, a hatchet and cell phone. On the interior overviews were taken of the apartment (Unit #703), multiple suspected blood smears and spatter, cartridge casings, suspected narcotics, a hat, firearm, Taser and suspected bullet defects.


