**Narrative:**

On Monday, October 28, 2024, Findlay Police Department requested Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) assistance at the scene of an officer-involved critical incident at Bernard Park: 1105 Bernard Avenue, Findlay, Ohio. As part of that investigation, Crime Scene Technician Emily Miller was requested to attend the post-mortem examination of the decedent, Calvin Darapheth, autopsy number [REDACTED]. The examination was conducted on October 30, 2024 at the Lucas County Coroner's Office in Toledo, Ohio. The post-mortem examination was conducted by Dr. Blomquist and Dr. Durham.

CST Miller requested to receive a copy of the full autopsy and toxicology reports once available.

As a result of the autopsy, the following items of evidence were collected and transferred to the custody of CST Miller:

1. Fingerprint Standard - Calvin Darapheth
2. DNA Standard - Calvin Darapheth

The aforementioned items were subsequently transported to the BCI office in Bowling Green, Ohio, where they were placed into the temporary evidence room. The evidence transfer sheet documenting the exchange is attached to this investigative report.
