## DISAPPROVAL, BOND FOR THE FAITHFUL PERFORMANCE OF HIS DUTIES AS RESIDENT DISTRICT DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF HIGHWAYS—EARL W. RIBER.

COLUMBUS, OHIO, June 20, 1935.

*HON. JOHN JASTER, JR., Director of Highways, Columbus, Ohio.*

DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my approval a bond in the penal sum of \$5,000 purporting to guarantee the faithful performance of the duties of one Earl W. Riber, as Resident District Deputy Director in Preble county, upon which the Ohio Casualty Insurance Company of Hamilton, Ohio, is surety.

Upon examination of this bond it is noted that in the first line of the bond the words

"and Earl W. Riber" do not appear after the word "Company". These words should be inserted therein.

It is also noted that the power of attorney gives authority for George R. Rabe, Sr., to execute bonds for the Ohio Casualty Insurance Company for a period of one year from the date hereof, *unless sooner revoked*. Such power of attorney is issued under date of June 30, 1934. A reference to the bond shows that a George R. Rabe executed the bond on May 24, 1935.

There is nothing to show that "George R. Rabe" is the same individual as George R. Rabe, Sr., to whom the power of attorney is issued. Besides, the back of the power of attorney is not filled out to bring it up to date at the time the bond was executed—May 24, 1935.

I suggest that Mr. Rabe sign the bond as "George R. Rabe, Sr." the manner in which the power of attorney is made out and the back of the power of attorney should be filled out to bring it up to at least May 1, 1935, so that this office may be assured that said power of attorney was not revoked and still in force on May 24, 1935, when the bond was executed.

I must therefore disapprove the bond at this time, and am forwarding herewith such bond and all papers in connection therewith.

Hathaway attached thereto, is made out under date of December 19, 1930, and there is no rider or statement to the effect that such power of attorney was in full force and effect on June 18, 1935, or shortly before such date, when the bond was entered into.

Also there is no financial statement of such bonding company.

In view of these omissions, I am unable to approve the bond at this time, and am returning same herewith.
