On Sunday, November 16, 2025, at 0730 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent Richard Ward, along with Sergeant Rachel Simmons of the Ohio State Highway Patrol – Investigative Services, attended the autopsy of Christopher Lindner at the Montgomery County Coroner's Office, located at 361 West Third Street, Dayton, Ohio.
