## APPROVAL, BONDS OF BELMONT COUNTY, \$38,250, FOR ROAD IMPROVEMENTS.

COLUMBUS, OHIO, July 3, 1922.

*Department of Industrial Relations, Industrial Commission of Ohio, Columbus, Ohio.*

Re: Bonds of Belmont county, in the amount of \$38,250, in anticipation of the collection of taxes for the county's share of improving Martins Ferry-Colerain Road, one bond payable in one installment of \$18,250 and one installment of \$20,000—6%.

GENTLEMEN:—I have examined the transcript of the proceedings of the county commissioners and other officers of Belmont county, relative to the above bond issue and find the same regular and in conformity with the provisions of the General Code.

I am of the opinion that a bond for said issue with combined principal and interest coupons attached, drawn in accordance with the bond resolution authorizing the same and in compliance with the resolution of the Industrial Commission, adopted under authority of section 1465-58a G. C. will, upon delivery, constitute a valid and binding obligation of said county.

Since the purchase of these bonds by the Industrial Commission, the commissioners of Belmont county, in order to meet the requirements of the Griswold act, have changed the denomination and maturity of the bonds, so that as now authorized they mature in two installments as indicated in the heading, one installment of \$18,250 November 1, 1923, and one installment of \$20,000 November 1, 1924. I suggest that your resolution of purchase be amended to correspond with the bonds as now authorized.
