**Narrative:**

On Thursday, June 09, 2022, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Jon Lieber (Lieber) received requested records and recordings from Ashtabula Police Department (APD). SA Lieber had previously requested all dispatch records, audio recordings (radio, 911 and phone), mobile data terminal (MDT) communications and any other dispatch/communications-related information related to the April 13, 2022, officer-involved shooting incident. As a result of that request, the following items were received and reviewed:

The dispatcher also advises that the male is intoxicated.

Officer-Involved Critical Incident - W. 46th Street, between Collins Blvd. and Valley View Blvd.

The dispatcher later states that the subject is now at Valley View Blvd. and the entrance to the bridge. She also states that two 875 units (Ashtabula PD units) arrived on scene.

The dispatcher advises that the subject has been advised to put the gun down. She also states that the subject said he has a 12 gauge.

There is additional radio traffic related to blocking off the roads.

**ward413.2 - ACSO**

This audio recording is 1 minute and 49 seconds in duration. The dispatcher advises that they block off traffic at Valley View. The dispatcher advises that the male has cocked the gun, and the male told the other dispatcher that he [the subject] is sorry and to tell the officers that he is sorry. An officer advises that he is with an APD officer and that the subject is on the bridge.

There is additional radio traffic related to blocking off the roads.

**ward413.3 - ACSO**

This audio recording is 2 minutes and 3 seconds in duration. There is radio traffic related to the location where officers should be blocking traffic. A deputy radios to dispatch to see if they can locate P8 (APD Officer Sheri Allen). The deputy says that he has a rapport with the subject. The dispatcher states that P8 does have the subject on the phone. Another deputy radios that he thinks P8 is at East 45<sup>th</sup> and Valley View.

**ward413.4 - ACSO**

This audio recording is 1 minute and 13 seconds in duration. The dispatcher advises that P8 lost contact with the subject. The dispatcher further relays that the last information is that the male was yelling at officers. A short time later, the dispatcher advises that they have the male back on the phone and they are attempting to transfer the call back to P8. An officer radios that the male is walking westbound on the bridge.

**ward413.5 - ACSO**

This audio recording is 21 seconds in duration. An officer radios that the subject is walking but only made it about 15 feet.

**ward413.6 - ACSO**

This audio recording is 21 seconds in duration. An officer radios that they have shots fired. Another officer radios that shots were fired and the subject is down.

This audio recording is 4 minutes and 33 seconds in duration. David Ward is transferred from the sheriff's office to Ashtabula City police. Ward says, "I have a gun to my head and I'm not afraid to die." Ward says that he is on East 46<sup>th</sup> Street on the bridge. Ward says, "Please don't stall because I want to die." The dispatcher says that there are people that want to talk to him. Ward indicates that he does not want to talk to anybody. Ward states, "I do have a 12 gauge or a 20 gauge so if the cops come I guarantee you I will pull it." Ward confirms that he is on the bridge. The dispatcher asks Ward to sit down to get his thoughts together. Ward says that he will not sit down and he is tired of it. Ward says that he is tired of it all. The dispatcher says, "But you're only 23." Ward replies, "I don't care."

The dispatcher tells Ward that he needs to put the gun down. Ward says, "I'm not going to put it down, I'm sorry sir. I don't want to hurt no officer but if I got to I got to. I'm tired of life you don't understand." The dispatcher asks what happened today. Ward says, "Everything. I have PTSD ok and it fucks me up." The dispatcher asks if he takes any medication for that. Ward says, "No." The dispatcher asks if he has seen anybody about it. Ward says that he has and he denied them. The dispatcher tells Ward that there is stuff he can take to help him. Ward says, "I'm just scared cause I don't want to hurt an officer. I respect them." The dispatcher says that nobody wants to hurt him either. Ward says that when they [police] show up, they will shoot him dead and he is ok with it. Ward says, "I'm ready to go son. I'm sorry to say but I'm ready to go." The dispatcher asks where his family is. Ward says that they are asleep and he doesn't want to give their number or name. Ward says, "Leave them be. Let me do what I need to do and let me blow my brains out."

The dispatcher asks Ward to calm down a little bit. Ward says that he is not going to calm down and that he is tired of life. Ward says, "I'm on the bridge at East 46<sup>th</sup> you want to find me come fucking find me." The dispatcher says that they know where he is but somebody would like to speak to him. Ward says, "You want to know what the shotgun sounds like (the sound of a shotgun action cycling can be heard)? That's what it sounds like."

Ward replies, "Well I'm not going to put it down so fucking deal with it." The dispatcher says that they are not going to do that. Ward says, "I'm waiting so where's your fucking cops." The dispatcher again says that they just want to talk to him. Ward says, "There's nothing to talk about. I'm ready to go some bitch." The dispatcher says that they are not going to do that and to hang on. Ward says, "I can hang on all you want, but it don't mean I won't either blow my brains out or go with, or go out by cop."
