Narrative:

On Wednesday, September 29, 2021, at approximately 1400 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Matt Collins (SA Collins) interviewed Jose Rodriguez (Rodriguez), relative to the officer-involved shooting which took place on 2469 Kimberly Pkwy. The interview took place at 2469 Kimberly Pkwy. E, Columbus, OH. Also present during the interview was Rebecca Burke (Complex Manager). The purpose of the interview was to obtain all relevant information of the incident known or observed by this individual.

Rodriguez is an employee at the Flats Apartments complex. Rodriguez stated he was inside Unit 'I-7' repairing a door when he heard multiple shots. He did not say how many there were, but indicated there were more than one. Rodriguez said he witnessed a subject running with no shirt on. He then locked himself in the apartment. When asked if he could further describe the subject, Rodriguez stated he could not even tell what race the subject was. See photo utilizing Bing Maps below for reference.
