Dear Sir:—This is to acknowledge the receipt of a communication from the Chief of the Bureau of Inland Lakes and Parks of the Division of Conservation in your department, enclosing for my examination and approval a certain reservoir land lease, in triplicate, executed by the Conservation Commissioner to one Ruth E. Fischer of Columbus, Ohio, which lease has been corrected in the manner suggested in my letter to that department under date of November 9, 1934.

By the lease here in question, which is one for a stated term of fifteen (15) years and which provides for an annual rental of twenty-four dollars (\$24.00), payable semi-annually, there is leased and demised to the lessee above named the right to occupy and use for cottage site and docklanding purposes the

inner slope and water front and the outer slope and borrow pit in the rear thereof of the northerly embankment of Buckeye Lake, that is included in the east half of embankment lot No. 80, as laid out by the Ohio Canal Commission in the year 1905, and being the same premises that were leased to one W. C. Heinmiller of Columbus, Ohio, by lease under date of August 9, 1904. It appears further in this connection that this lease is a renewal of a lease granted to said W. C. Heinmiller under date of November 1, 1919, which lease has heretofore been assigned and transferred to said Ruth E. Fischer, who is now the owner of the same.

Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by the Conservation Commissioner and by Ruth E. Fischer, the lessee therein named.

I further find upon examination of this lease and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained, that the same are in conformity with Section 471 and other sections of the General Code of Ohio relating to reservoir land leases.

I am accordingly approving this lease as to legality and form as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon the lease and upon the duplicate and triplicate copies thereof, all of which are herewith enclosed.

HANEFELD, Director, Department of Agriculture, Columbus, Ohio DEAR SIR:—This is to acknowledge the receipt of a recent communication over the signature of the Chief of the Bureau of Inland Lakes and Parks, submitting for my examination and approval a reservoir land lease, in triplicate, executed by the Conservation Commissioner to one George Hirsch of St. Marvs. Ohio.

This lease, which is one for a term of fifteen (15) years, and which provides for an annual rental of twelve dollars (\$12.00), payable semi-annually, there is leased and demised to the said George Hirsch as the lessee therein named, the right to occupy and use for cottage site and docklanding purposes that portion of the outer slope of the easterly embankment of Lake St. Marys that is included in Embankment Lot No. 21, numbering south from the southerly line of the right of way of the Lake Erie and Western Railroad, as shown by H. E. Whitlock's plat of embankment lots on the east bank of Lake St. Marys, made under the direction of the Superintendent of Public Works in June, 1920, and being a part of the southeast quarter of section 8, town 6 south, range 4 east, Auglaize County, Ohio, excepting therefrom a driveway 25 feet wide off of the easterly side of said embankment lot, which is to be
