Narrative:

On Monday, May 13, 2024, at approximately 1230hrs, SA Boerner attended the autopsy of De'Shawn Vaughn. The autopsy took place at the Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner's Office and was conducted by Dr. Elizabeth Mooney (CCMEO # IN-2024-00707). The purpose of this report is to document the injuries observed to the body of Vaughn and is not meant to be a full record of the autopsy conducted by Dr. Mooney.

The body of Vaughn exhibited multiple suspected gunshot wounds. Vaughn exhibited suspected gunshot wounds to the right side of his head (contact wound, with back spatter on his right hand), the left side of his head (exit) and left knee.

Fragments were located outside and inside the body of Vaughn. Projectiles were located on the left thigh and inside the left knee. The fragments were collected by Dr. Mooney and will be forwarded to the Cuyahoga County Regional Forensic Science Laboratory (CCRFSL) as evidence.
